Termly update from Tracey

Hi all,

Summer term is here! We are all looking forward to spending as much time learning outside as possible. We have started off the term looking at bugs, flowers and bees and we have two baby Pigeon's nesting in our hedge in our playground. We will continue the coming weeks exploring our wonderful environment and nature around us, linking learning with stories, songs, craft and fun.

The children are really enjoying our Forest School area; they have enjoyed making dens, digging mud, mixing and making, mirroring the Pre-School activities which enable the children to learn in various ways. We are planning on planting a herb garden at Forest School and we have been watching our resident Robin and Pheasant. We have also ordered two big planters for our playground to create vegetable gardens.

Update on the playground: - we are currently getting some round fence poles to roll the shed over to the other side of the playground. Then we can order concrete to fill in the hole, then we plan to roll the shed back, astro turf the concrete and create a new garden space (with our new planters) for the children to enjoy.

Throughout this term we will continue to follow the children's interests, and will be getting the children who are leaving us "school ready" for September. "School ready" means putting on their own coats/shoes, doing up zips, independent toileting, using cutlery, opening their own lunches/drinks bottles. We will continue with Read Write inc. phonics,

mathematics in various ways together with pen and scissor control. The children are also becoming really good at listening and sitting nicely.

Then, on the last day of the summer term we are holding our Fun Day and Graduation Ceremony, to wish the children who are moving on to school the very best for the future.

Fees

Please note that our current hourly fee rates are £7.00 per hour for 3 and 4 year olds (i.e. £17.50 per 2 ½ hour session) and £8.00 per hour for 2 year olds (i.e.£20.00 per 2 ½ hour session). These rates apply to both funded and non-funded children i.e. funded children if their funded sessions are all used or are used at another setting. Please note that Breakfast Club, After School Club and lunch sessions are charged at the same rates.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Charges (depending on child's age) are:

8am – 9am £7/£8 (Please book in advance)

8.30am – 9am £3.50/£4.00 (This can be used on an ad-hoc basis)

Funding can be used to cover the sessions if available. Bookings are non-refundable.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

We are now offering wrap around care until 5pm Mondays to Thursdays and 4pm on Fridays.

Sessions cost £7/£8 per hour and MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE.

ENHANCED CHILDCARE FUNDING FOR WORKING PARENTS

Uniform/Labelling/Lunch Boxes
